Kuwaitis, Yemenis discuss ties

Six Kuwait-funded mobile schools spring up in N. Iraq

BAGHDAD, Dec 25, (KUNA): A string of six mobile schools opened Monday in Iraq's northern Nineveh province, all financed by the Kuwaiti Relief Society.

The schools are now up and running and are overseen by Kuwait's ambassador to Baghdad Salem Al-Zamanan, Chairman of the United Iraqi Medical Society Ahmad Al-Haiti told KUNA.

Al-Haiti added that he was grateful for Kuwaiti aid that will prove instrumental in propping up his country's ailing education sector, citing a number of similar schools and clinics that have been built recently.

Meanwhile, the head of the Kuwaiti-Yemeni Relief Society Raed Ibrahim and Yemen's Minister of Social Affairs and Labor Ibtihaj Al-Kamal on Monday discussed plans for closer ties between both sides.

The Yemeni minister heaped praise on a Kuwaiti campaign that provided her war-torn nation with aid that encompassed various fields including education, healthcare and nutrition, a statement by the Kuwaiti-Yemeni Relief Society read.

She hailed Kuwait as an altruistic nation that has always stood by the Yemeni people in times of adversity.

Meanwhile, Ibrahim thanked the Yemeni minister for her efforts to ensure that the society's work goes unimpeded, saying it was the result of a solid rapport between both sides.

The Kuwaiti-Yemeni Relief Society comprises a number of charities from both nations that work to deliver Kuwaiti aid to the Yemeni people.

KUWAIT CITY, Dec 25: Minister of Justice and Minister of Awqaf and Islamic Affairs Fahad Al-Afasi announced that the ministry has launched several new electronic services for the public including the immediate registering and lifting of travel bans electronically at the border checkpoints, reports Al-Seyassah daily.

In his press statement issued during the launch of the web portal www.moj.gov.kw, he revealed that this is his part in the e-government project.

Al-Afasi indicated that the portal will facilitate some of the departments in Ministry of Justice and Ministry of Interior in lifting travel bans as soon as such restrictions are cleared by the concerned departments of Ministry of Justice.

He added that the other services which have been launched include enquiry about the status of power of attorney, which will benefit both the private and public sectors.
