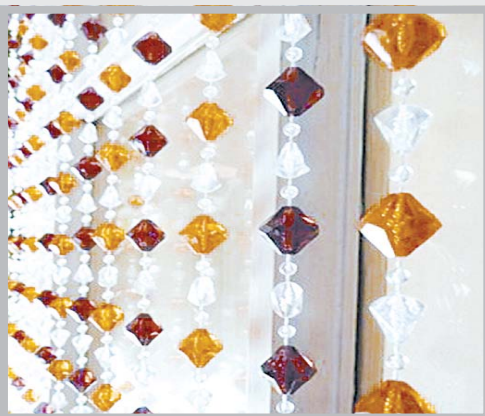

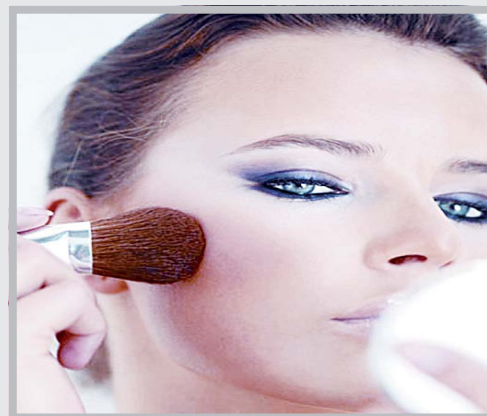


mansoa alliacea

Mansoa alliacea commonly known as Garlic Vine or Ajos sacha is an evergreen tropical shrubby vine that is native to the Amazon rain-forest. It can either be described as a shrub or a vine since it produces numerous woody vines from the root that grow only 2-3m tall and form a shrub-like appearance. The garlic vine is named so because of its leaves and its flowers with its garlicky smell when crushed. This vine is even used as substitute for garlic in food.

Site: Full sun to half-shade.
Temperature: Hardy to 30°F (-1°C), avoid freezing temperatures.
Water: Keep compost moist, but do not over-water.

Square Face is characterized by slightly wider forehead, an equal measurement of jaw line. Start with applying usual concealer, foundation, loose facial powder.

flank steak

Ingredients: 12-ounce orange marmalade; 1/2 cup vinegar; 1 tsp chili powder; 2 tsp A-1 steak sauce; 1/2 cup ketchup; 2 tbs Dijon mustard; 1 tsp Worcestershire sauce; 3 pounds flank steak; salt and pepper.

Method: In bowl, combine all ingredients, mix them up well. Set aside 1 cup of marinade, add flank steak, coat well. Cover, refrigerate overnight. Preheat barbeque grill until it's hot. Put the steak on grill & pour some of marinade on top. After minute to get good sear, flip flank steak over & pour a bit more of marinade on that side. Turn barbeque burner down to medium. Flip again after 4 more mins, remove after 4 additional minutes.
