## 44 domestic recruitment bureaus suspended

## PAM provides all support to manpower

Food stockpile enough for 9 months

## Agency to be set up to manage crises

KUWAIT CITY, July 13: State Minister for Economy Affairs Maryam Al-Aqeel has emphasized dedicated efforts of the Public Authority for Manpower (PAM) in providing all kinds of protection and support to manpower in the country by dealing with challenges they face with their sponsors in various sectors, reports Al-Qabas.

In a statement, Al-Aqeel

explained that PAM formed a specialized team in the department of domestic workers, which was transferred to the authority last April and distributed into five sections with a total of 34 employees in charge of following up cases related to domestic workers.

The sections consist of administrative support, domestic workers' arbitration, inspection, and licensing, and they all perform 22 procedures aimed at protecting the rights of domestic workers and to provide them care, in addition to restoring the rights of employers in case an error occurs through the local recruitment bureaus.

Also, Al-Aqeel indicated "in a friendly agreement, the domestic workers department in cooperation with the admins of various social media platforms managed to bring down advertisements for domestic workers (Maids), such as those that advertised the 'sale of maid' or 'transfer of maid', in addition to constant follow up on social media and referring viola-

tors to the human trafficking department of Interior Ministry.

"Kuwait returned a domestic worker to her country immediately it realized that she was underage. The decision came after the concerned department learnt about it via a special British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) documentary. The department also continues to issue violation citations to domestic workers recruitment bureaus while suspending their licenses through the Interior Ministry and Manpower

She revealed that 44 domestic workers recruitment bureaus had been suspended as of June, 2019, and that PAM is out to pursue violators in those bureaus and impose financial guarantee on the bureaus or employers or aggrieved domestic worker to reassess their respective rights. It also entails follow up of absconders and referring those refusing to work to the domestic workers shelter where their cases will be sorted prior to their deportation.

The Ministry of Commerce and Industry had earlier confirmed that the country's strategic food stocks can suffice for about 9 months, while the Ministry of Health said the stockpile of medicines and medical supplies was good enough for 6 months.

In a related context, the sources confirmed that work is under way in full swing to provide additional quantities of fuel products by the introduction of new service tanks, noting that the fuel reserve is currently sufficient for more than 30 days, while the concerned authorities are working to double those reserves.

## Culture

Al-Ghunaim noted that Israel is continuing to force Palestinians out of their homeland, pointing out that Kuwait condemns such actions, especially in attempting to deform the Palestinian Identity, religion and culture in forcing them out of Jerusalem.

The Ambassador stressed Kuwait's keenness on respecting legal rights of the Palestinian people, as well as voicing Kuwait's concerns over recent provocative Israeli actions in Palestinian lands after an Israeli government official have broken into Al-Aqsa Mosque.

Furthermore, Kuwait Ministry of Awaqaf and Islamic Affairs provided a donation worth KD 70,000 (\$230,000) for the expansion of Islamic projects in Montenegro.

Kuwaiti Ambassador to Serbia and non-resident Ambassador to Montenegro Yousif Abdulsamad met with Montenegrin Islamic official and delivered the donation to build an Islamic education center in capital of Podgorica on Monday.

Ambassador Abdulsamad also handed over to a Montenegrin official a donation from the Kuwait-based Islamic Heritage Revival Society worth KD 36,700 (\$120,000) to build a mosque in a city north of Montenegro.

Kuwait's humanitarian policy and framework is to support Arab and foreign countries in developmental projects related to culture, education and infrastructure.

## Charitable

Afterwards, Montenegrin official praised Kuwait's contributions and its prominent role in charitable and humanitarian work to help Muslims in Montenegro.

On another level, The Yemeni government signed on Tuesday an agreement of cooperation with Kuwait Society for Relief (KSR) to fund a water and electricity project in Aden and Abyan governorates.

This agreement comes in light of "Kuwait beside you" campaign that has been organized by KSR for several years.

The Yemeni Minister of Water and Electricity Mohammad Al-Anani during the signing ceremony praised the continuous Kuwaiti support for Yemen through different times and circumstances.

The agreement states on importing and installing an electrical power plant that exceeds 10 megawatt as a donation presented by KSR for the Yemeni government.

And it also states on completing the third stage of the (Aden grand waters) in Abyan governorate, in addition to improving electricity for the citizens near the project site.

Moreover, Kuwait Red Crescent Society (KRCS) supported feeding one Billion starving people initiative by distributing 4 million meals with basic nutrition for needy people around the world.
