

Sanheim scores in OT as Flyers pip Bruins

Avalanche edge Wild to extend point streak to 15 games

BOSTON, April 6, (AP): Travis Sanheim scored 3:08 into overtime, and the Philadelphia Flyers beat Boston 3-2 after losing their first five meetings with the Bruins this season.

The Flyers moved within three points of Boston for the final playoff spot in the NHL's East Division.

Travis Konecny and Sean Couturier also scored for Philadelphia, and Brian Elliott stopped 27 shots. The Flyers were 2-4-2 in their previous eight games.

Patrice Bergeron had a second-period goal for Boston that moved him into fourth on the club's career scoring list with 899 points, one ahead of Rick Middleton.

Karson Kuhlman also scored for the Bruins, who have collected at least a point in seven of their last nine games (5-2-2). Dan Vladar made 29 saves.

Avalanche 5, Wild 4

In St. Paul, Minn., Nathan MacKinnon, Andre Burakovsky, Brandon Saad and J.T. Compher scored during Colorado's four-goal second period, and the Avalanche extended their league-best points streak to 15 games.

The franchise record is 16 outings with a point from Dec. 27, 2000-Jan. 30, 2001.

Gabriel Landeskog also scored for Colorado, and Philipp Grubauer stopped 21 shots for his fourth straight win.

Ryan Hartman had a goal and two assists for Minnesota, which had won 11 straight at Xcel Energy Center since losing 5-1 to Colorado on Jan. 30. Nick Bjugstad and Marcus Johansson scored in the third period as the Wild tried to rally, and Kevin Fiala scored on a power play with 35 seconds left, but Minnesota couldn't get the equalizer.

Canadiens 3, Oilers 2, OT

In Montreal, Eric Staal scored in overtime in his Montreal debut, giving the Canadiens a come-from-behind win.

Staal beat Mike Smith with a wrist shot 4:02 into overtime. Montreal improved to 2-9 in overtime games. Edmonton fell to 2-2.

Devin Shore and Darnell Nurse scored for Edmonton, which managed goals in the last minute of both the first and second periods. Smith made 29 stops.

Josh Anderson and Tomas Tatar scored for Montreal in its third-period comeback. Carey Price had 21 saves.

Tomas Nosek, Jonathan Marchessault and Nicolas Hague also scored for Vegas, which had dropped three in a row. Robin Lehner made 31 saves.

Tyler Bozak scored for St. Louis. Ville Husso made 14 saves on 19 shots before he was replaced by Jordan Binnington.

The Blues are 0-6-1 with just eight goals scored since March 22.

Everton denied by late goal

West Ham into EPL's top four despite Antonio, Rice injuries

LONDON, April 6, (AP): West Ham jumped above Liverpool, Tottenham and Chelsea into the top four of the Premier League.

Injuries to arguably its two best players might see the team struggle to stay there.

Jesse Lingard inspired a 3-2 win over Wolverhampton as the midfielder ran from the halfway line to score one goal and also set up another for substitute Jarrod Bowen.

Lingard has now scored six goals in eight games since joining on loan from Manchester United in February, a hot streak that has seen him earn a recall to the England squad.

The victory saw West Ham climb into fourth place – the final Champions League qualification position – with eight games remaining, continuing its revival under David Moyes. The London club has never played in Europe's top competition.

"We have to go and take it on. Why not?" Moyes said. "I am hearing pundits talking about West Ham having a chance of Champions League – nobody would have envisaged or mentioned that last season."

Dike lifts Barnsley in English 2nd tier

LONDON, April 6, (AP): American forward Darryl Dike had his second two-goal game for Barnsley, helping his team to a 2-1 win at Luton Town in England's second-tier League Championship.

The 20-year-old from Edmund, Oklahoma, on loan from Major League Soccer's Orlando, gave the visitors the lead in the 27th minute after Alex Mowatt's free kick into the penalty area dropped following an attempted headed clearance by Glen Rea. Dike turned and volleyed with a right-foot shot from 16 yards.

Dike doubled the lead in the 59th, running onto a pass from Cauley Woodrow and beating goalkeeper Simon Sluga with a right-footed shot from just inside the penalty area.

Dike has seven goals in 13 league matches since joining Barnsley.

Barnsley is fifth with 68 points with six games remaining, one point behind Brentford and Swansea, two points ahead of Reading and three in front of Bournemouth. Norwich leads with 84 and Watford is second with 79.

The top two teams at the end of the season are promoted to the Premier League, and the third-through-sixth-place teams advance to a playoff for the final promotion place.

However, Moyes is set to be without Declan Rice reportedly for at least four weeks, with the holding midfielder missing the game at Molineux after getting injured on international duty with England last week.

Also set for a spell on the sidelines is Michail Antonio, who left the field because of a hamstring injury in the 32nd minute. It is the latest setback for the injury-prone Antonio, who has been transformed from a winger to a rampaging center forward under Moyes and is the only senior striker in West Ham's squad.

Antonio barged through a slew of challenges before shooting wide from a narrow angle, then immediately signaled to the West Ham bench.

Pablo Fornals scored the other goal for West Ham, which led 3-0 after 38 minutes only to be pegged back by Leander Doncker's header in the 44th and a goal by substitute Fabio Silva in the 68th.

But after throwing away a 3-0 lead to draw 3-3 against Arsenal in the previous round, West Ham held on for the win this time.

Wolves has also picked up an injury ahead of the league run-in, and it's a big one. Jonny Otto, the Spain wing back, damaged anterior cruciate and medial cruciate ligaments in his right knee in training on Sunday and

is set for a long absence. He only just returned from six months out with an ACL injury in the same knee.

West Ham's win came after Leicester and Chelsea, the teams who started the weekend in third and fourth place, lost on Saturday while Tottenham was held 2-2 by struggling Newcastle on Sunday.

West Ham is a point ahead of fifth-place Chelsea and four behind third-place Leicester.

Everton conceded an 86th-minute goal to draw 1-1 with Crystal Palace, missing out on a victory that would have lifted Carlo Ancelotti's team within three points of West Ham with a game in hand.

Michy Batshuayi came on as a substitute in the 84th minute and made an immediate impact by driving a left-footed shot into the bottom corner.

Colombia playmaker James Rodriguez had marked his first appearance for Everton in six weeks by breaking the deadlock in the 56th minute.

Everton stayed in eighth place, still well in the hunt for the European positions.
