KDIPA attracts KD 106m from 8 new companies

KUWAIT CITY, June 22: According to informed sources, the Kuwait Direct Investment Promotion Authority (KDIPA) succeeded in attracting new investments worth about KD 106 million from eight new companies during

the last period, reports Al-Anba daily.

They said that the cumulative number of approvals granted by the authority to companies by the end of March 2021 amounted to 59, adding, "That number has now risen to 67 approvals

by eight new companies".

The sources highlighted the fact that the value of investments rose from KD 1.203 billion at the end of March 2021 to about KD 1.309 billion currently, with an increase of KD 106.1 million.

KUWAIT CITY, June 22: The Kuwait Flour Mills and Bakeries Company has sent a letter to Mohsen Al-Mutairi, Deputy Director General of the Livestock Affairs sector the Public Authority for Agricultural Affairs and Fish Resources (PAAAFR), regarding the current bran allocations in light of the internal changes, which resulted in a decrease in the flour sales, which is mainly related to the production of bran products, reports Al-Qabas daily.

It has been reported the PAAAFR will be providing the mills company 4,000 tons of bran instead of the 6,750 which is not good enough.

The company said bran is the byproduct of wheat, which makes the production of bran directly related to the production capacity of the flour, and not a product ready for packaging and delivery, and therefore its production depends on market conditions and the sales volume of flour.

The sources indicated that the company spoke of its inability to continue to cover the current required quantities of bran, starting from July and until further notice will affect the market.

Team conducts inspection campaigns

'PAM will not tolerate violations regarding law on noon work ban'

KUWAIT CITY, June 22, (KUNA): The Public Authority for Manpower (PAM) stressed on Wednesday that it will not tolerate violations on enforcement of the law regarding noon work ban.

The official spokesman and director of the Public Relations and Media Department of the authority, Aseel Al-Mazyed, stressed in a press statement the need to abide by the decision to ban the employment of workers at noon, which prohibits the employer from employing workers in open places between 11 am and 4 pm for the period extending from the first of June until the end of August.

PAM indicated that a monitoring team is conducting inspection campaigns in all regions of the country, especially those

under construction sector, adding that the process of conducting the violation is carried out directly according to strict procedures.

It stated that the inspector, when he confirms the presence of workers in violation of the decision, issues a notice of one working day, and the site is re-inspected on the next day, pointing out that in the event that the violation continues, the employer will be issued the necessary violation in application of the regulations and decisions regulating.

It called for using the designated hotline number 99523590 to receive communications submitted by citizens and residents to be dealt with by the dedicated work team.
