# Kuwaiti official looks forward to up joint Arab action at all levels

Al-Abduljalil heads team

**CAIRO, Sept 4, (KUNA):** A Kuwaiti official expressed Wednesday hopes that decisions taken by the Arab League's social and economic council will enhance the joint Arab action on all levels.

In a statement to KUNA, Head of Kuwait delegation at the meeting, Assistance Undersecretary for Economic Affairs at the Finance Ministry Nabeel Al-Abduljalil said that the council discussed several issues of the joint Arab economic and social work.

The discussion included the reports of the Secretary-General of the Arab League on following up with the implementation of decisions taken during the 103th session of the council, and Economic and Social Sector Activity in the General Secretariat between the 103rd and 104th Sessions.

The council focused on economic and social issues, ahead of a forthcoming Arab summit slated for March, Al-Abduljalil added.

## Discussion

The discussion included the requirements of the completion of the Arab Free Trade Zone, the Arab Customs Union, and investment in the Arab countries.

On other hand, the council discussed the "periodic" economic issues such as Support the Palestinian economy, Unified Arab Economic Report 2019, United Arab Discourse for 2019, and the Arab Food Security Report 2018).

It followed up the implementation of the resolutions of the Arab Economic and Social Development Summit in its fourth session held in Beirut last January as well as resolutions of the Arab-African summit in its fourth session in Equatorial Guinea in November 2016.

The meeting following up the implementation of (Riyadh Declaration) resulted from the fourth summit of Arab and South American countries in Saudi Arabia in 2015, he referred.

The council also discussed the follow-up to the implementation of the Arab Strategy for Aquaculture (2017-2037), the strategy of sustainable agricultural development (2005-2025), and the Emergency Plan for the Arab Food Security Emergency Plan (2017-2021).

The Economic and Social Council concluded its 104th session with the participation of senior officials in the Arab ministries of finance and economy.

Starts with 1,000 shares

## 5 segment offers for citizens in N. Al-Zour subscription shares

**KUWAIT CITY, Sept 4:** It has been revealed that the five sections of subscriptions to be floated for interested citizens in the shares of the North Al-Zour Company will start with 1,000 shares, followed by 3,000, then 5,000 which will later be doubled to 10,000 and ending with 20,000 shares, reports Al-Rai daily.

Informed sources said the public subscription will be done online through logistic systems to be provided by Kuwait Clearing Company (IPO Kuwait) - an online platform that provides all types of public offer services and available once the application is downloaded on the smart phone.

The National Investment Company manages the offers based on agreements reached for the process, which will see to offering of 550 million shares worth KD55 million, which means that the value of each share is 100 fils. An agreement has since been reached with 15 local and GCC banks to participate in the offering through the K-Net service.

The participating banks include the National Bank of Kuwait, Kuwait Finance House, Boubayan Bank, Burgan Bank, Commercial Bank of Kuwait, Gulf Bank, Kuwait International Bank, Al-Ahli United Bank, Al-Ahli Bank of Kuwait, Warba Bank, the Bank of Bahrain and Kuwait, Al-Rajhi Bank, and National United Bank.

Sources noted that Kuwait Investment Authority (KIA) has 5 percent of North Al-Zour Company's capital investment, while the Public Institution for Social Security keeps 5 percent, and Al-Zour mother company maintains 40 percent share.

## 'No popular govt decisions soon'

**KUWAIT CITY, Sept 4:** The Council of Ministers and its committees have not discussed resolutions on loan waiver for citizens, debt buy-back or provision of grants for citizens, but the possibility that some ministries are carrying out relevant studies whose reports will be transmitted to the Cabinet for review cannot be ruled out, reports Al-Rai daily.

A source informed that in case a popular decision is on ground it requires review to ensure alignment with the current needs.

He said such move will be discussed quickly in line with the government's general direction.

He explained the current government direction is focused on development projects and plans, which are in line with the general policy.

He reminded that the daily in a previous edition made reference to the possibility that the government might be well disposed to some popular decisions, considering the hints gathered from some lawmakers.
